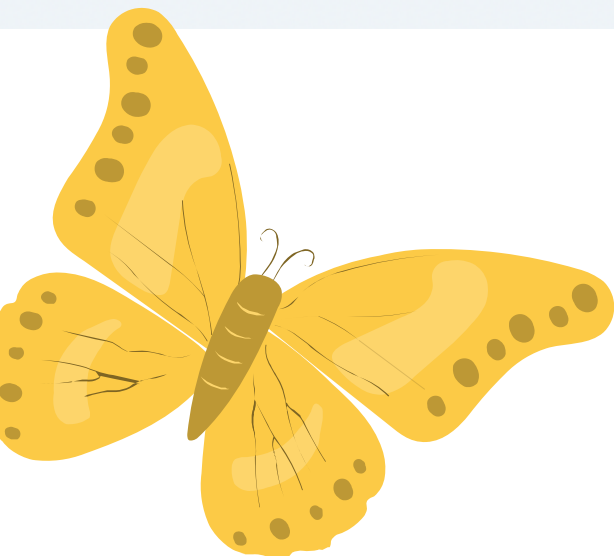

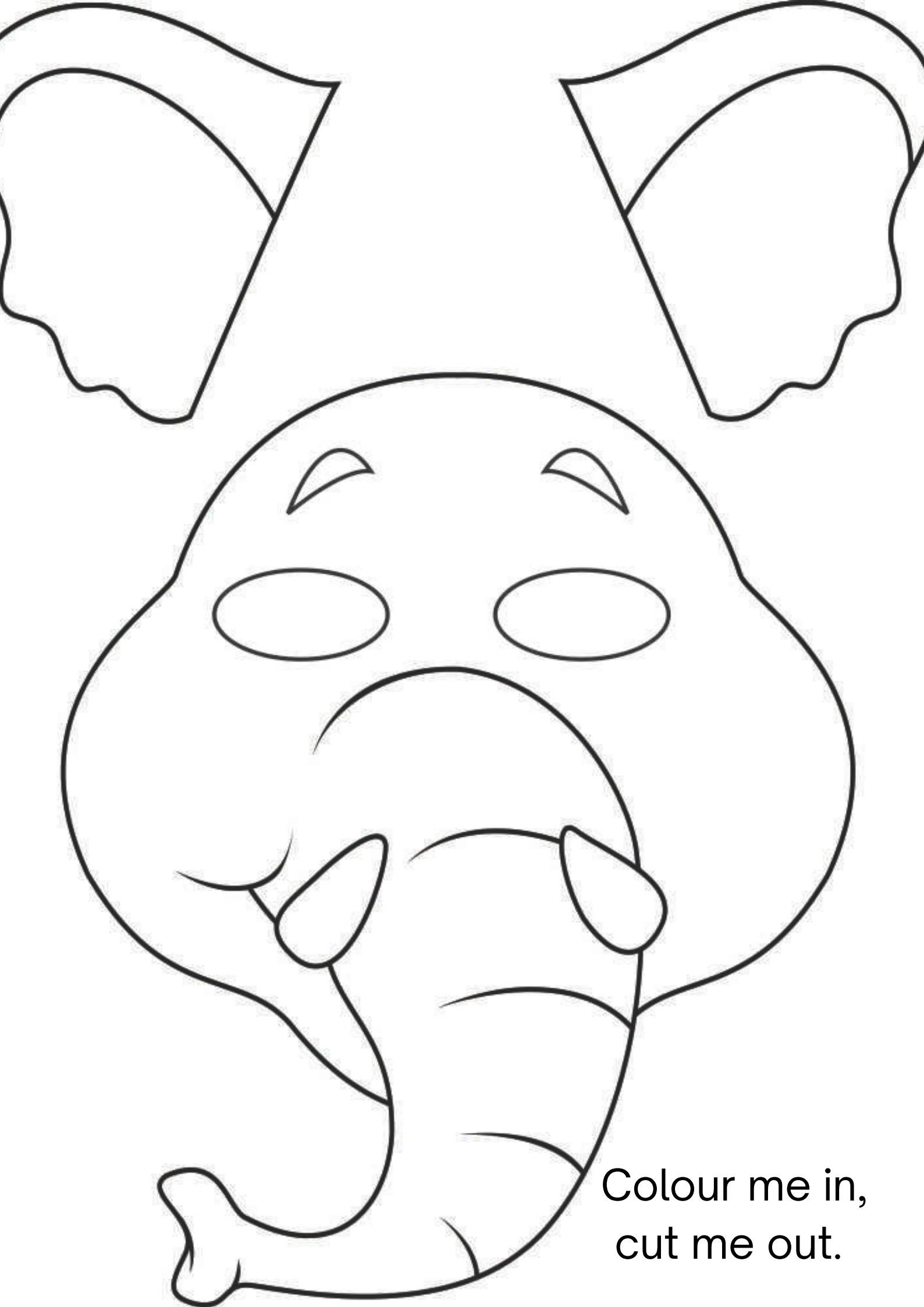


FUN FACTS ABOUT THE JUNGLE

The Living Pharmacy: More than 60% of all anti-cancer drugs originate from natural sources, including plants found in the rainforest.

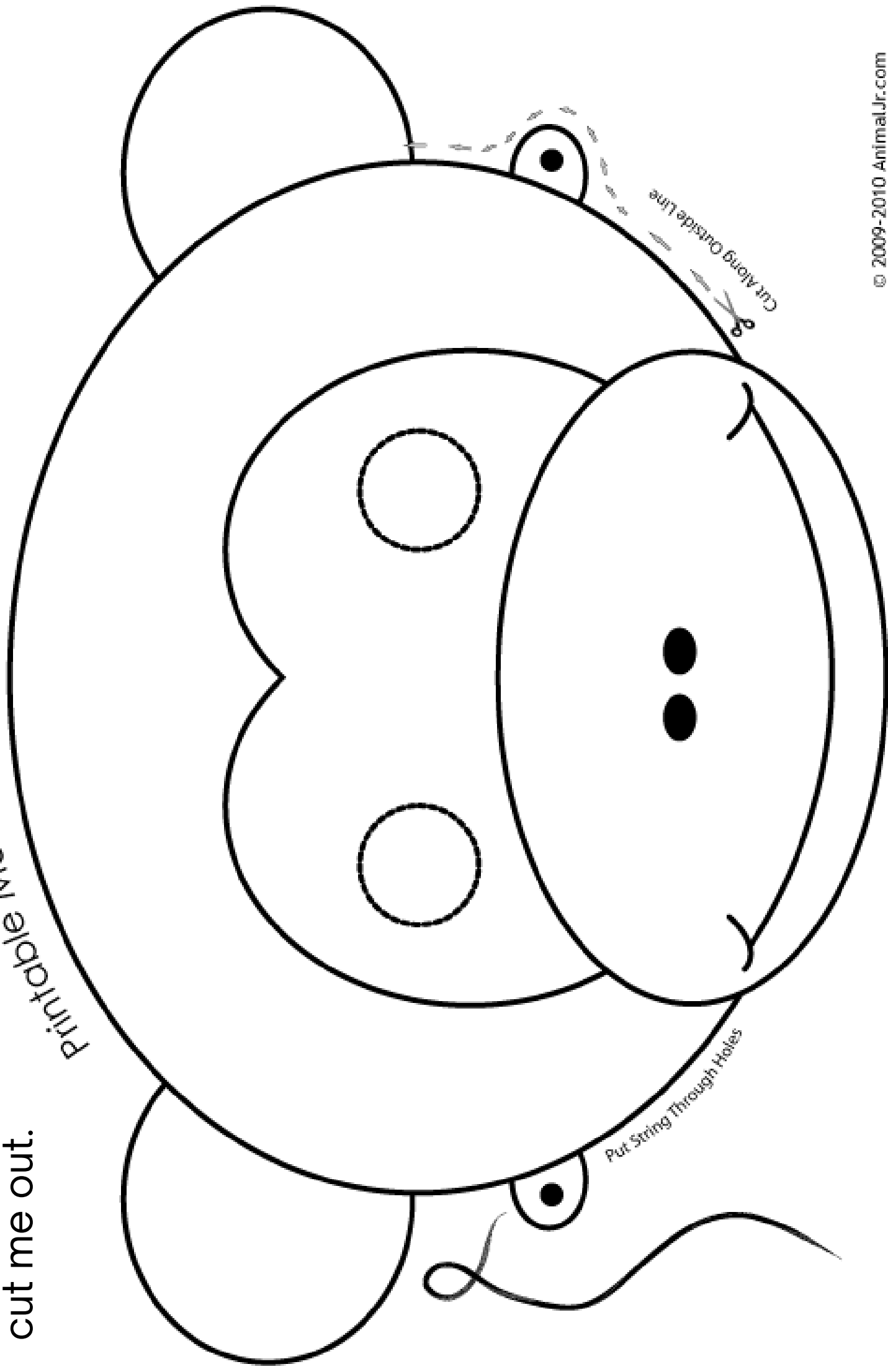
The World's Oldest: The Daintree Rainforest in Australia is the world's oldest continuously surviving tropical rainforest, having existed for over 180 million years.
